Precipitation key: (general watering guidelines)

Desert: less than 10" annual precipitation

Semi-Desert: 10" - 15" annual precipitation

Foothill: 15" - 20" annual precipitation

Mountain: 20" - 30" annual precipitation

Riparian: more than 30" annual precipitation
